Extended Care Service Information

Extended care is a service available to all campers on a daily or weekly basis.

AM Care 7:00–8:30 a.m.
\$30/week or \$7/day per child

PM Care 3:30–6:00 p.m.
\$45/week or \$10/day per child
Payments for this service are due the first Tuesday of each session or for the one time use at the time of drop off or pick up.

FROM THE DIRECTORS

Creative Themes would like to continue with our excellent safety and camper satisfaction record. Please help us to make camp a safe and fun environment for each and every camper and parent.

Creative Themes would like to continue late nights instead of over nights this summer.

These will be held during our 2 week session. Our goal is to schedule them on one of the Thursday nights during those sessions. They will be for 2nd grade and older, start at end of camp day (3:00pm) and last until 8:00pm. A sign-up sheet will be sent home the 1st day of these sessions.

Once again we would like to remind campers that proper shoes for our environment are shoes or sandals that have good soles and attach to the foot. Closed-toe shoes and sandals are preferred. FLIP FLOPS are not appropriate foot wear choices, as they leave feet exposed to the elements, give no support during play, and are an accident waiting to happen. Please, do not send the children to camp with FLIP FLOPs as their main foot wear.

Leave at Home: For our campers protection, safety, and comfort we ask that they leave all cell phones, electronic games, and music devices at home. Creative Themes is a place to enjoy the outdoors and not be preoccupied with these items. It is also a place where things can be misplaced, lost, stolen, or easily damaged. Creative Themes has a phone if communication with a camper is necessary (385-6830).

Drive Thoughtfully: Drive carefully both to and from camp. Respect the neighbors on Eaglehead Rd. Drive slowly and cautiously; remember, this is where they live and their children play.

Keep in mind that Creative Themes Camp facility is in an outdoor environment. Be smart in how you dress, the shoes you wear, and the things you bring to camp. Also, be careful in your trip to and from camp.

CAMP POLICY

Pick up/Drop off: If you are dropping off after the 9:00 a.m. time or picking up before or after the 3:00 p.m. time you will need to report to the office to sign you child in or out.

Releasing Campers: If your child will need to be picked up during the day a note should be sent to their counselor that day. Please make sure the name of the person who will be picking up the child is indicated, this person should report to the office to pick up the child.

3:00 Pick Up: We will bring all campers who are leaving at 3:00 p.m. to the parking lot. Our staff will assist in loading all campers into their

cars. For everyone's safety please follow the staff's directions.

Extended Care: Our staff will need to sign all campers in and out during these times. Please make sure you report to the staff signing out campers.

Camper's Behavior:

- Campers are expected to respect and listen to the camp staff.
- No taking of other campers' stuff.
- No fighting or bad language will be tolerated.
- No destroying camp property.

At Creative Themes we know that each camper has different interests, our program activities touch these different interests in many ways.

9:10-9:25 a.m.

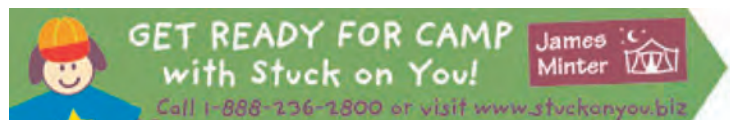
We all meet at the amphitheater for morning announcements.

All groups participate in scheduled activities for about 35minutes each. These include:

- Swim Lessons
- Game Time
- Theme Time (activities based on session theme)
- Art
- Activity Time (fishing, canoeing, archery, and theater)
- Lunch

Free Choice Time (All camp activities are open with staff stationed around the different areas.)

2:35-2:55 p.m.

2:55-3:20 p.m.

Afternoon pick up (campers are brought to the parking area to be picked up).

Take it slow, listen to staff, and be patient in the parking area.

Drop off (8:30–9:00 a.m.) Staff will be in the parking lot to help campers out of their cars, if you need to park you will need to go to the middle of the circle.

Pick up (2:55–3:25 p.m.) Campers will be brought to the parking lot and helped into cars by staff.
